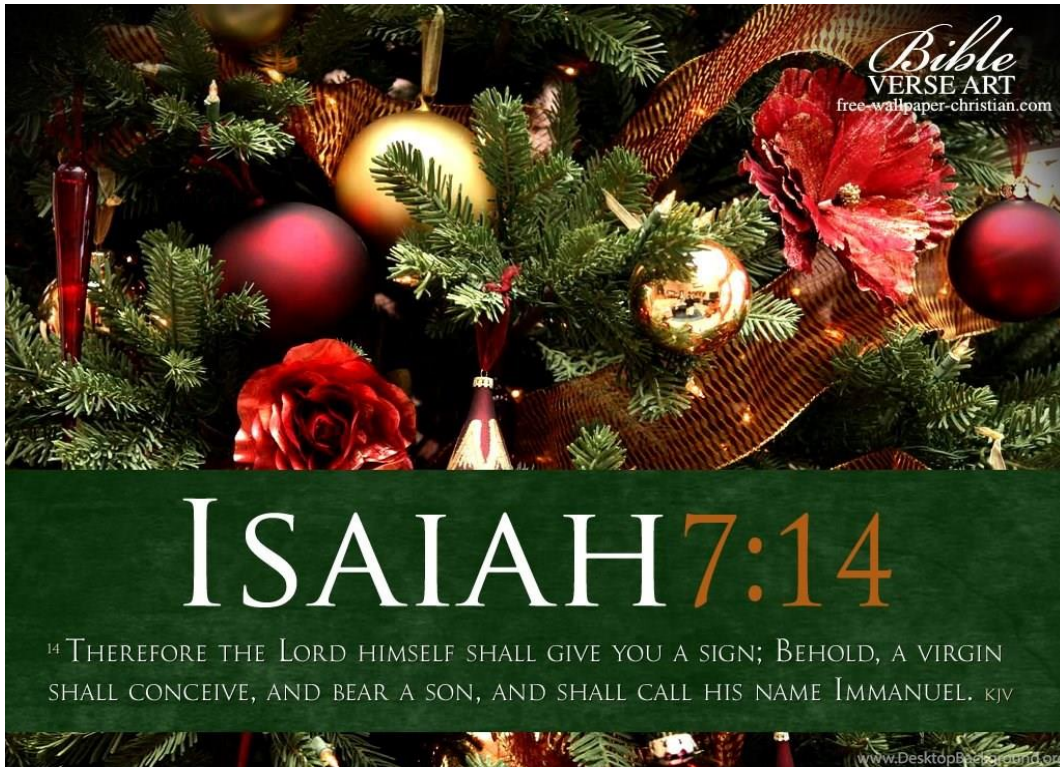

Thoughts from Pastor Mike

Anticipation – we've all seen it, little kids bouncing up and down, fidgeting, impatiently wondering "How long?" As we get older, we learn to manage our feelings and actions, but we can still be impatient. So it was with the Jews of Jesus' time. They had been living under Roman oppression and were wondering how long until the promised Messiah would come to set them free. They looked forward in eager anticipation of one who would reign with justice and righteousness.

The Messiah did come, but instead of setting them free politically, He set them free spiritually. Free from the control of sin, and from the fear of death. Not what they expected, instead something more, with eternal rather than temporal consequences. Too often we get caught up with the physical things around us and lose sight of the bigger spiritual picture. Paul writes in 2 Cor. 4:18 that we should fix our eyes on what is unseen rather than what is seen, for the seen is temporary while the unseen is eternal.

Similar to the Jews of Jesus' day we are now awaiting the second coming of the Messiah. We look at the world around us and ask, "How long?" We long to see the return of Jesus when everything will be made right, and evil will be stomped out once and for all. We don't know how long it will be, but there is much to do in the meantime. Many people still haven't heard or don't believe. May we use the remaining time to advance the Kingdom, bringing hope and the promise to others.

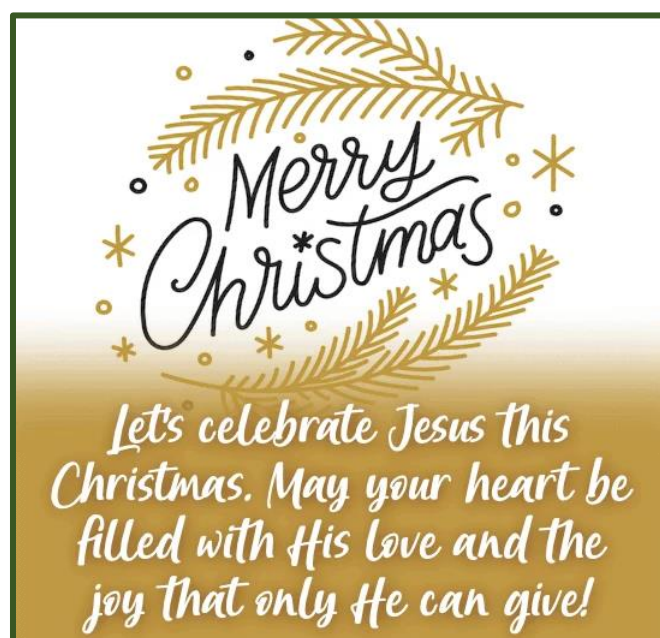

The Season of Advent is our journey toward Christmas. The word *advent* means “coming” or “arrival,” and the season is marked by expectation, waiting, anticipation, and longing. Advent offers us the opportunity to share in the ancient longing for the coming of the Messiah, to celebrate His birth, and to be alert for His second coming.
