Thoughts from Pastor Mike

Hi Everyone,

A new year brings new opportunities and a renewed hope for the future. I have spent part of the week studying the word hope in preparation for this week's sermon. The Biblical definition of hope is quite different than the modern English version that is familiar to us. We think of hope as the desire that something good will happen in the future. We see it as a possibility and associate it with one crossing their fingers to somehow increase the odds of something coming about.

The Biblical definition is rather different. In the Old Testament we find three words for hope, *yachal, tiqvah* and *qavah*. While these are slightly different being case specific, the general sense of the words to wait for something in expectation.

The New Testament was written in Greek and the word for hope, "*elpis*", can be translated as a trust or confidence and has a positive connotation. It is something that we are looking forward to in a positive way rather than something that we are wishing for as a possibility. Another way to describe it is as a confident expectation.

I think it would be nice if the translators of the Bible had selected a different word for hope when they wrote it in English. I would recommend reading your Bible with the above meanings in mind. You will see things in a different light and be filled with reassurance.

May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit. (Romans 15:13)
