# LENT MUSIC DEVOTIONS

The following first paragraph was to be included in our Ash Wednesday Service, which was cancelled due to weather. The message of Lent is powerful and is a very rich season for the Body of Christ and as individuals. May we experience a deep, profound love and devotion for our wonderful God and beautiful Savior!

### Our Invitation this Lent...

Dear friends in Christ, every year we celebrate Christ's death and resurrection. Lent is a time to prepare for this

celebration. In order that our Lent may be a time of renewal and growth we begin this season by remembering our need for repentance and for the forgiveness of God proclaimed by Jesus Christ. I invite you, therefore, in the name of Christ, to observe a holy Lent by self-examination and repentance, by prayer, fasting, self-denial, and giving to those in need, and by reading and meditating on the word of God.

There are so many great hymns and songs that can aid us in connecting with our Lord. You can sing them or recite the lyrics. Songs can be used to begin our devotion time. This is a great way to open up and turn our hearts and minds to hearing from Him. Four song favorites of mine for this season are Purify My Heart, When I Survey the Wondrous Cross, At the Cross (Love Ran Red), and The Wonderful Cross and I have included the lyrics for you.

If you have a hymnal at home, I encourage you to get it out and use songs to connect with God for devotion, repentance, thanksgiving, and prayer. Draw near to God and He draws near to you! What comfort and peace we receive.
